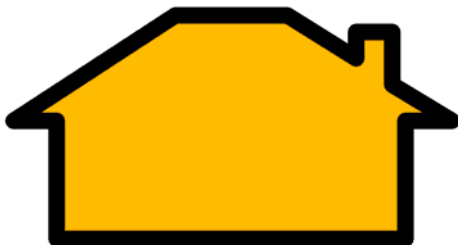
- 6:00 Appetizers & Cocktails – The Bachler's

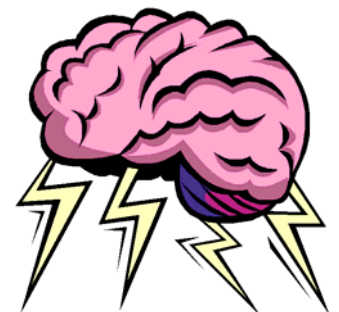

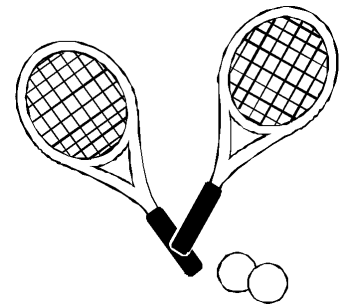
