Get Ready to Make A Splash! The Pool's Opening!!!



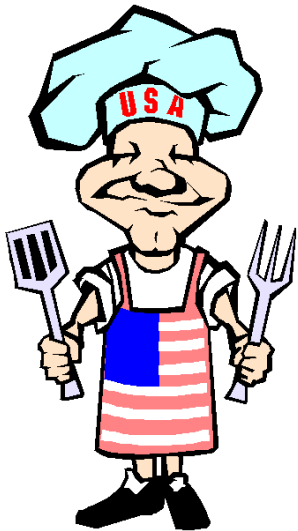
Yup, it's that time of the year....put those sweaters and long pants away and get out your shorts and that beloved swimsuit....the Pool's Opening!

MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND TENNIS TOURNEYS

This year we're holding three separate tennis events through the weekend to give us the most tennis and lots of flexibility:

Men's Doubles – Saturday, 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Women's Doubles – Sunday, 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Mixed Doubles - Monday. 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

FORMAT

All three events are a high-low format, so all members who enjoy tennis are encouraged to join in. We would like to have a minimum of 8 teams (16 people) for each event.

Players will be matched into doubles partners (one high, one low) before the first round. You play with that partner throughout the tournament. Each round will be one modified pro-set, no ad, with the first team winning eight games (win by two games) moving to the next round. If the set is tied 8-8, then an ALTA rules tiebreaker is played.

CASH PRIZES!

Each event will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd place cash prizes. The prize purse is funded from the \$5 entry fee per person per event. 1st place gets 50% of the purse, 2nd place gets 30%, and 3rd place gets 20%. The more players, the higher the winnings! Each player will also bring a can of balls.

The club is providing beer, water and sodas throughout the weekend for the tournament.

And Another Tennis Camp....

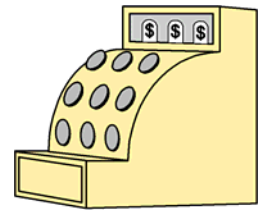
Tennis camp will be offered this summer at the club from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon, July 8-12 if there is enough interest.

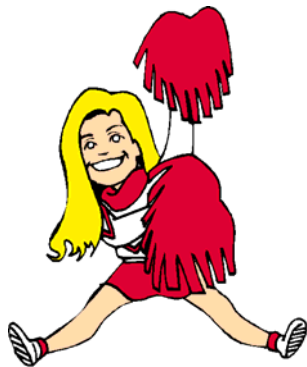

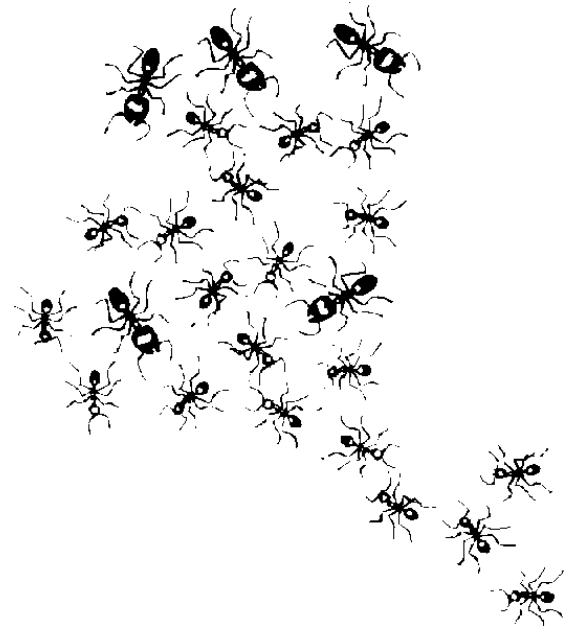

News you can Use from our Local Police Precinct



North Precinct Police Commander, Major T. W. Bush has asked the parents of DeKalb to team up with his officers in a concerted effort to declare **ZERO TOLERANCE** for the violators of the child restraint and safety (seat belt) laws of the State of Georgia. According to Major Bush, "Traffic crashes account for the majority of deaths of people between the ages of 1 and 35 years, and analysis data shows that either the lack of, or the improper use of child restraints and seat belts are directly related to this bleak statistic.

Georgia Traffic code 40-8-76 states that each occupant (regardless of age) of the front seat of a passenger automobile, and each minor over four years of age who is an occupant (regardless of seating location), must be restrained by a seat safety belt. Passenger automobile means any vehicle designed to carry ten passengers or less (excluding taxicabs), and includes any sport utility vehicle and pickup truck for any occupant under 18 years of age. 40-8-76 also states that it is the responsibility of every driver to insure that *all children four years of age or under are properly restrained in a child safety seat* which has been approved by the U.S. Dept. of Transportation under Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213. *(This approval will be noted on the child safety seat)*. The seat must be installed and being used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, and the child must be restrained by straps, harness or restraint device **and** the child safety seat must be secured correctly with the vehicle's belt system. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration strongly recommends that you have your child safety seats inspected by a certified child safety seat technician and follow the four steps of child passenger safety:

1. Use rear-facing child seats for children from birth to at least 20 pounds and at least one year of age.
2. Use forward-facing child seats for children over 20 pounds and at least one year old to about 40 pounds and about age four.
3. Use belt-positioning booster seats for children from about 40 pounds to about 80 pounds and 4' 9".
4. Use seat belts for older children large enough for the belt to fit correctly: at least 4' 9" and about 80 pounds.

Major Bush has instituted proactive policing efforts such as "*education of the public to seat belt laws*" as well as **roadblocks and high profile techniques** dedicated to enforcing these laws. And he is urgently appealing to all citizens to remind their friends and loved ones to **BUCKLE UP**. If you get stopped for a seat belt violation, there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE**. It's either "**CLICK-IT or TICKET!**"
