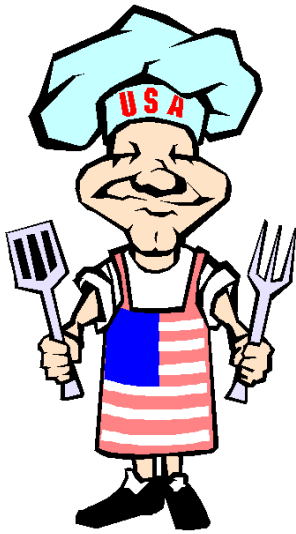
Pool Management

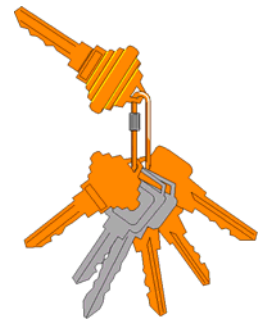
