She is having a second youth camp August 5 through 9 from 9 a.m. to noon. To sign up contact Jane at 770-394-5097 or xena46@aol.com

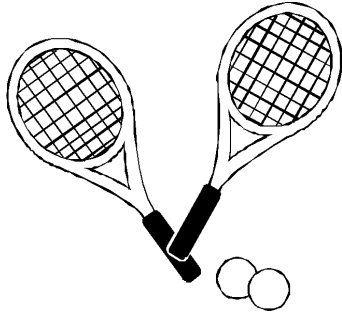
Fall ALTA Season
