

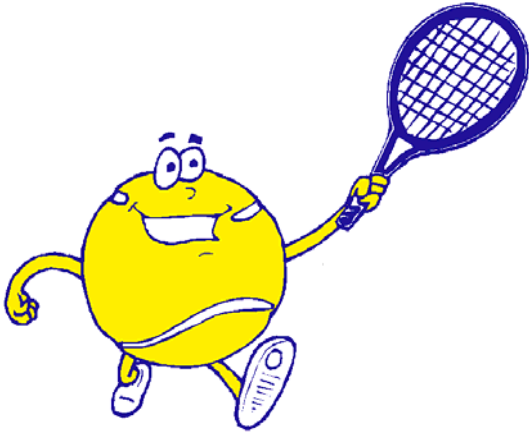

Fun at the Club During Labor Day Weekend

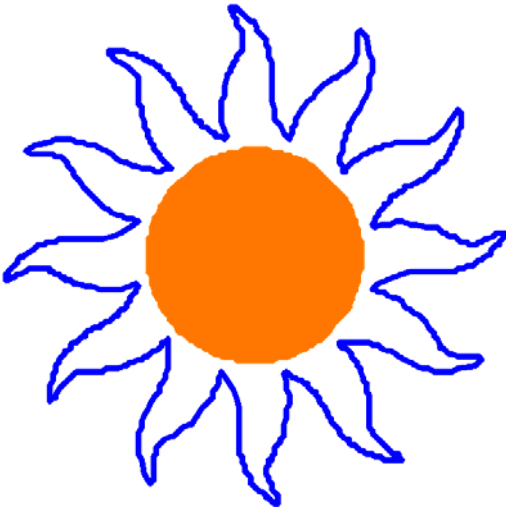
Grab your tennis rackets, swimsuits, and appetites for the Club's annual Labor Day Weekend festivities. The weekend kicks off with an all-weekend tennis tournament followed by a cookout on Sunday, September 1 at 5:30pm.

This year there are three separate tennis events through the weekend to give everyone the most tennis and lots of flexibility. Players in the last tournament asked for more time between rounds (to rest!) so the events are longer so there will be more time in between rounds.



Men's Doubles – Saturday, 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Women's Doubles – Sunday, 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
Mixed Doubles - Monday. 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Format: All three events are a high-low format, so all members who enjoy tennis are encouraged to join in. The goal is eight teams (16 people) for each event. Players will be matched into doubles partners (one high, one low) before the first round, playing with that partner through out the tournament. Each round will be one modified pro-set, no ad, with the first team winning eight games (win by two games) moving to the next round. If the set is tied 8-8, then an ALTA rules tiebreaker is played.



Cash Prizes: Each event will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd place cash prizes. The prize purse is funded from the entry fee. Each person pays \$10. \$5 of the fee funds the prize purse: 1st place gets 50% of the purse, 2nd place gets 30%, and 3rd place gets 20%. The more players, the higher the winnings! The other \$5 pays for beverages (beer, Mike's, sodas and water) and tennis balls for the tournament. Players should bring fruits and snacks.

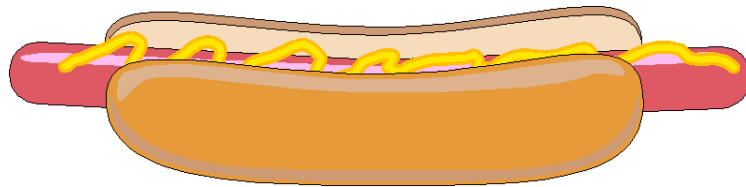

Swim & Dive Team and School of Fishes 2002 Recap

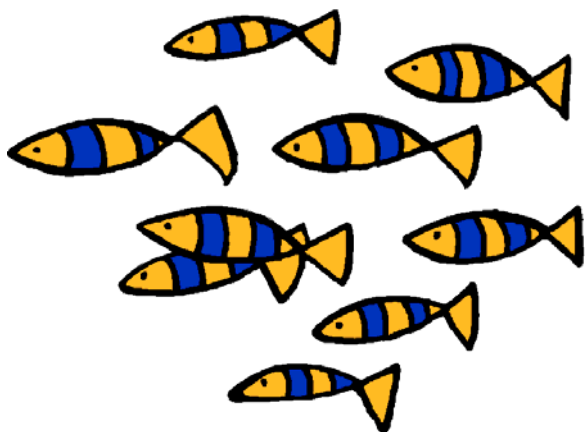

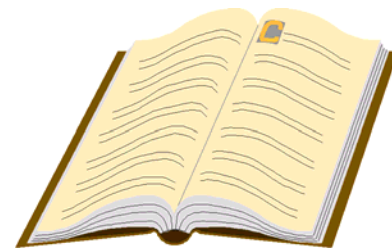
