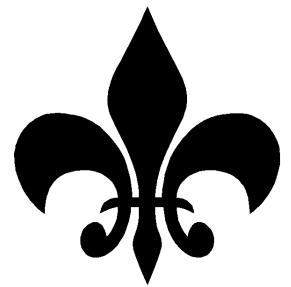

The FSTC Board recently scheduled some very important dates for members. With only 3 ½ months left to 2002, the calendar is filled with the following FSTC socials and meetings.

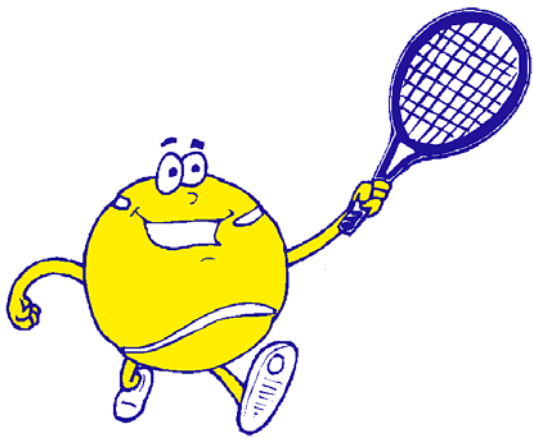

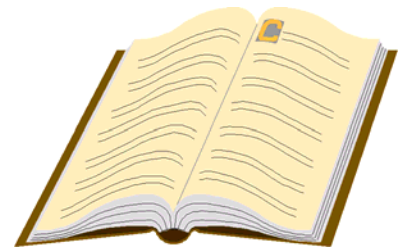
New Members

Upcoming Classes at the Clubhouse

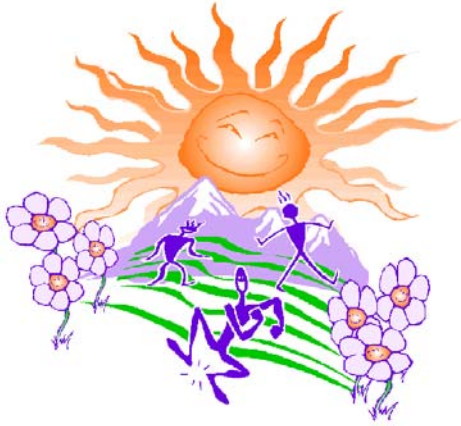
