- Richard Osterholtz

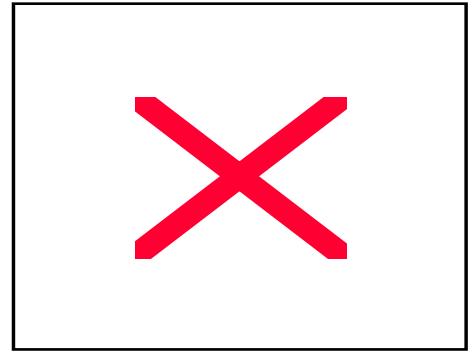
