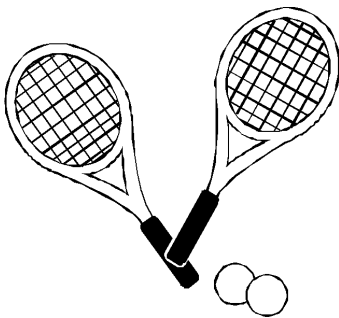

Twister Boys Lead the Way at Swim Championships

The Fontainebleau Twisters' swim team, led by 14 year old swimming sensation James Clements, tallied 52 points at the NASA Swim Championships held June 26-28 in Alpharetta.

Clements, whose 3rd place finish in the 50 Free earned him another team record with a sizzling 25.73, also finished 13th in the 100 IM accounting for 28 out of the team's 52 points. Mark Alvis was the only other Twister to score individual points as he placed 19th in the 11-12 50 Free with a personal best time of 31.85.

Also scoring points for the Twisters was the 15-18 Boys relay team. The team consisting of Curtis Brideau, Candler Wingo, James Clements and Cameron Ferguson, placed 18th in the 200 Medley Relay with a time of 2:04.85 and followed that up by shattering their own team record in the 200 Free Relay with a mind numbing time of 1:47.67 for a 16th place finish.

The 15-18 Girls relay team consisting of Cassie Anchors, Emily Gleason, Chloe Forman and Laura Smith also set a team record in the 200 Free Relay with a time of 2:04.63 while finishing 25th.

Divers Do Fontainebleau Proud

Fontainebleau divers also did well at the GADL Dive Championships held on June 25th at the Brookwood Hills pool in Buckhead.

Chloe Forman finished 8th in the 15-18 Girls with a total score of 153.25 and Shawna Klein finished 10th in the 13-14 Girls with a total score of 105.10.

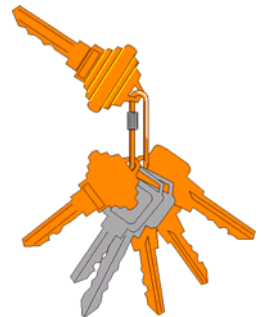
Board Meeting
