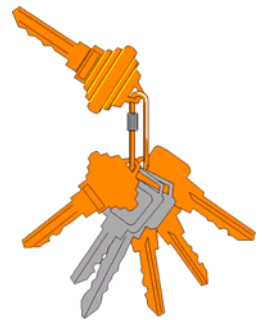
## **Board Meeting**
