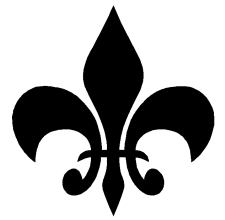

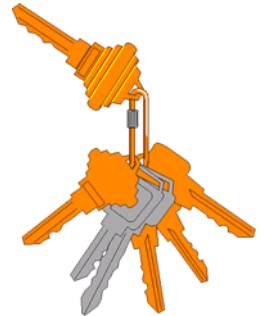
Board Meeting
