## Game Night Is Coming!

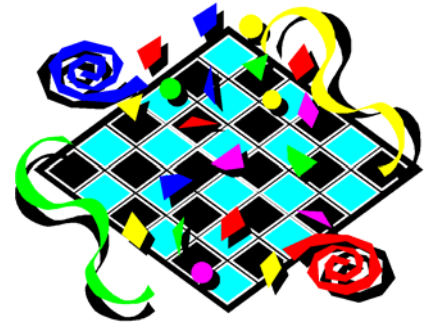

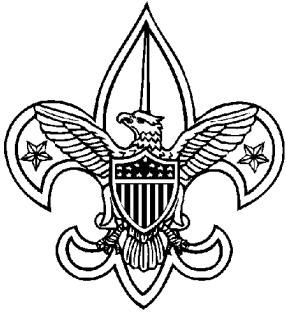
