USTA Summer Team forming: Contact YvEtte Sahara (770-698-9803) if you are interested in playing on a Thursday morning USTA team this summer. USTA's format is two single matches and three double matches so the team only needs eight people available on a weekly basis. The season starts June 3 and runs through July 22 with matches scheduled on Thursday at 9:00am. Registration is in April. The level of the team will either be a 3.0 (ALTA mid C to low B) or 3.5 (ALTA mid to high B) depending upon the majority of the players' ranking. Club Dues: In order to end the confusion over conflicting messages about when the Pool membership dues are actually due, we have included a copy of the amendment to the By-Laws passed this last November. If you have any questions about your bill, please contact Kyle Kolvereid at (770) 396-2126.

"Dues shall be sufficient to provide for the necessary expenses of the club and the proper maintenance and improvements of its property. Said dues shall be due on **April 1** of each year and may be paid in on lump sum on or before April 1 or in four equal installments commencing on February 1 and continuing on March 1, April 1 and May 1.

The Club membership year shall run from April 1 – March 30. Any installment or special assessments or any other sums owed to Fontainebleau Community Club, Inc., not paid by the due date shall be subject to a late payment charge equal to 10% of the installment or sum owed. In no event, however, shall such late payment charge be less than \$1.00 or more than \$10.00. "
