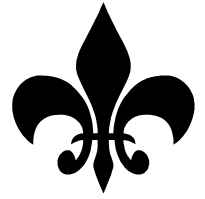

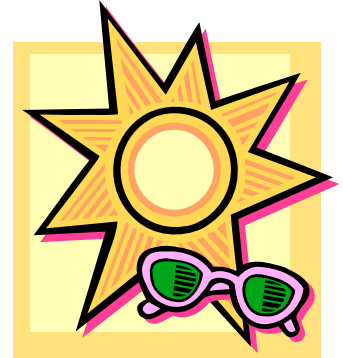

Brian Domit will attend Georgia Southern University. Brian was also named "Youth of the Year" at All Saints Catholic Church.

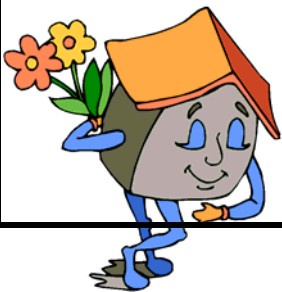
Dana Jacobson will attend Georgia Southern University.

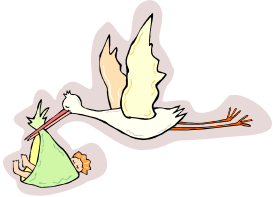
New Members
