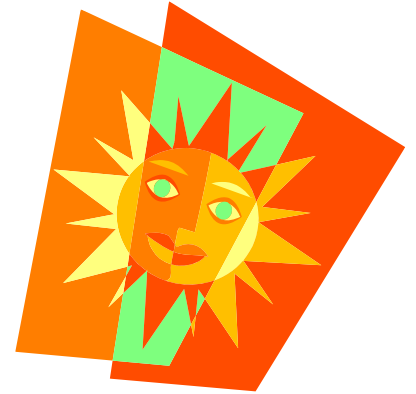

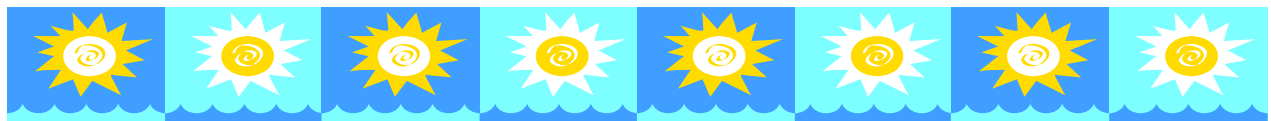
# FSTC Celebrates Labor Day Weekend

Now that the summer season is over, upcoming social events include the annual Chili Cook-off. Watch for details!





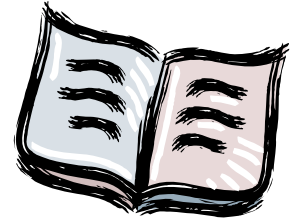
## New Members

Jessica Cardwell (almost 14) is available to babysit after school (4:30) and on weekends.

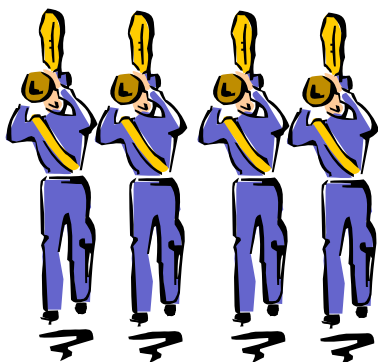
## Dunwoody High School News
