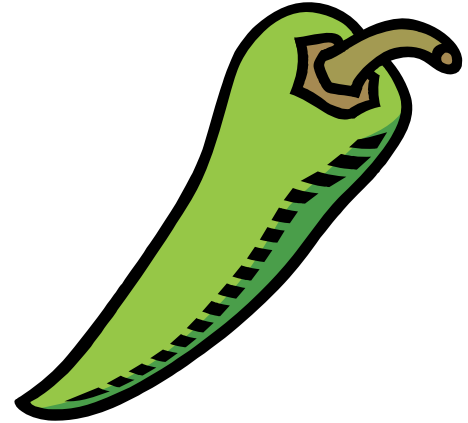

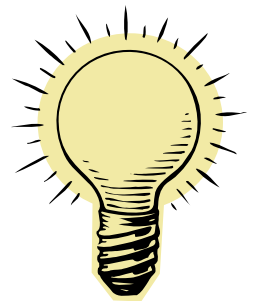


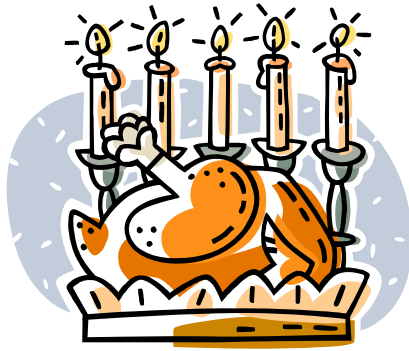
### Storm Damage
