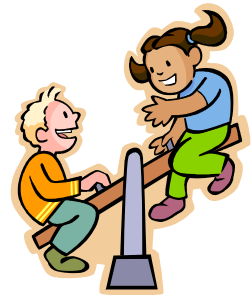
It's sure to be a great night. Look for invitations in the mail in the coming weeks.
