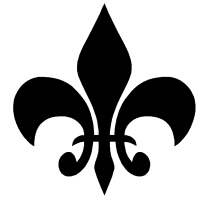

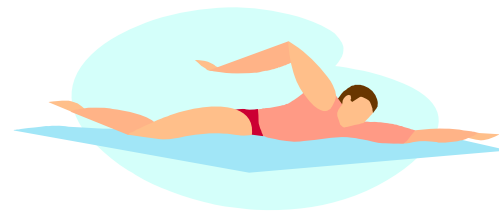

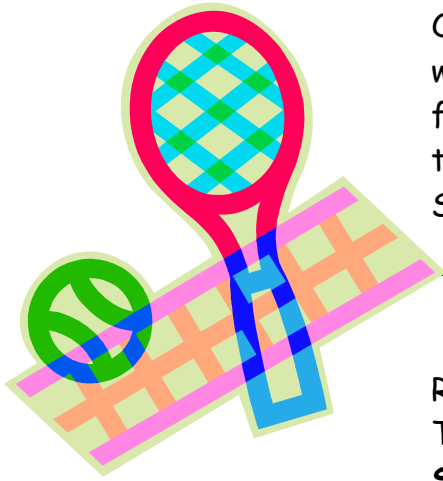

The Lock-Box for the Restrooms is installed!

Thanks to Richard Osterholtz for his work in installing the Lock-Box for the restrooms. This will make entry to the restroom much easier for all tennis teams. The Lock-Box is right outside the Entry Door to the Restrooms. With your Main Gate / Tennis Gate key you can unlock the Lock-Box and extract the Entry Door Key (it will be on a cord). After unlocking the Entry Door, replace the key back in the Lock-Box, and lock the Lock-Box.

Again, a reminder: After all matches are completed, lock the Entry Door before departing to insure the security of our facilities (a key is NOT required to lock the Entry Door).
