## TENNIS LESSONS FOR ADULTS

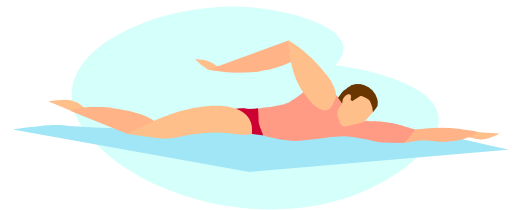
