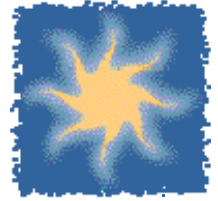
### **A Note From the President . . .**

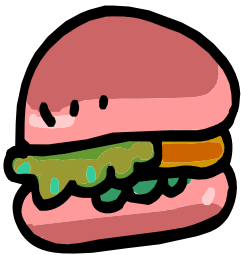

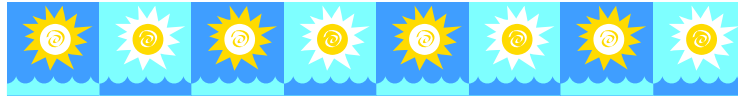
