Member News

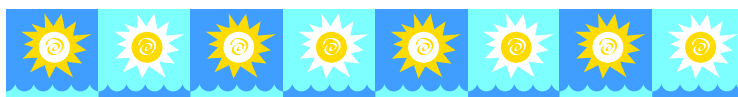

Tuesday, June 21 home meet against Rivermont

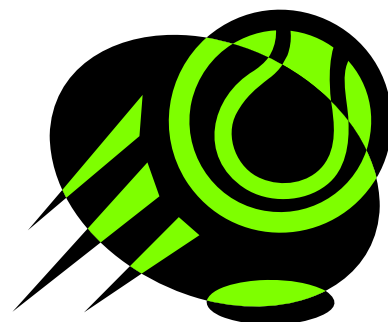
Tuesday, June 28 home meet against Gainsborough
