The teams want to thank all the parents who volunteered their time and energy in making the 2005 season a success. Before you know it, plans for next year will get underway.

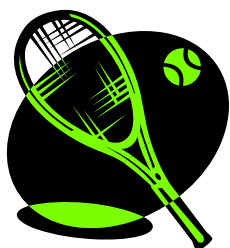
A Message from the President...

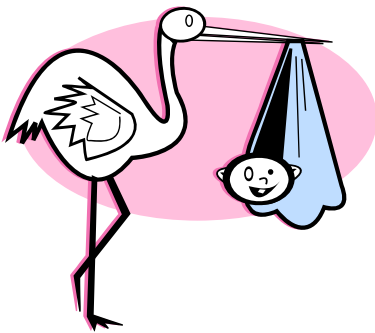
