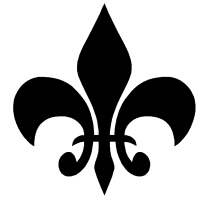




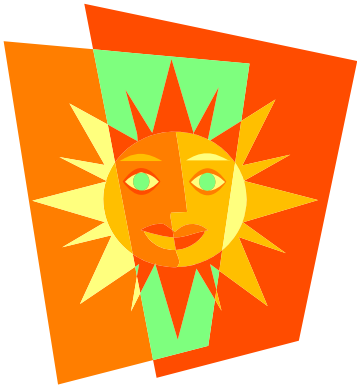

Thank you, Miss Donna!



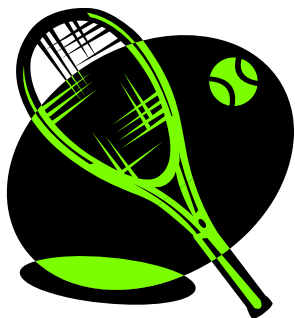
Affectionately known as Miss Donna, Donna Burt has been a shining star for the Fontainebleau Swim Team for 33 years!

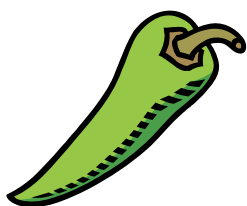
These two men won their Division's tournament over the summer and were pictured in the latest season's ALTA Magazine. We have that picture on the bulletin board at the courts.

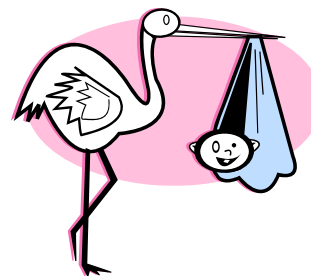
