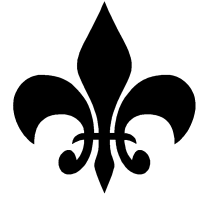

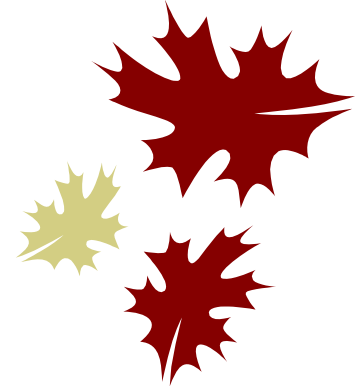

Mark your calendar for the following important events:

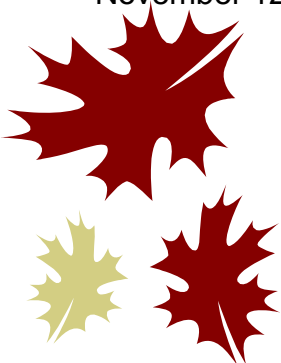
Grounds Clean Up Day	November 5	9:00 – Noon

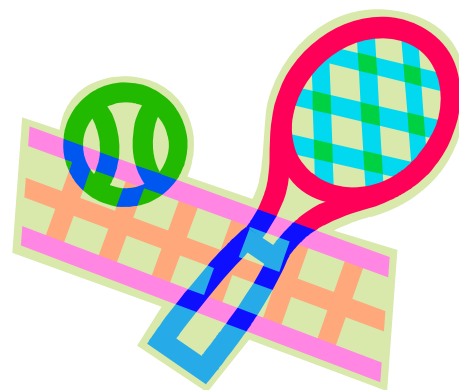

### School News

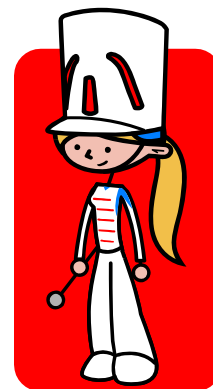
#### **Dunwoody High School Garage Sales & Open Market**
