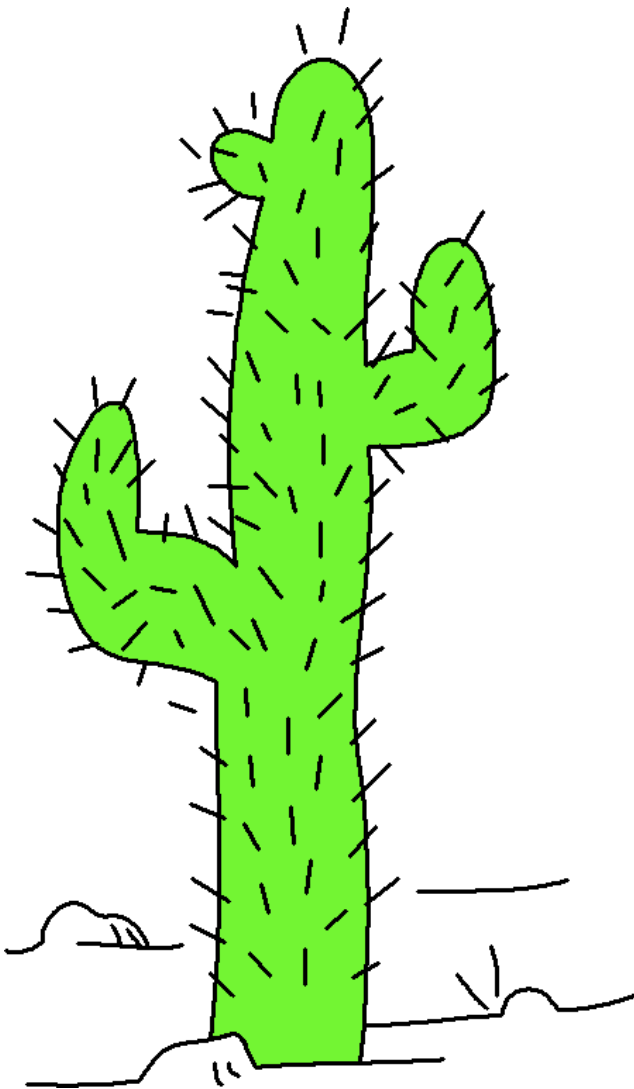

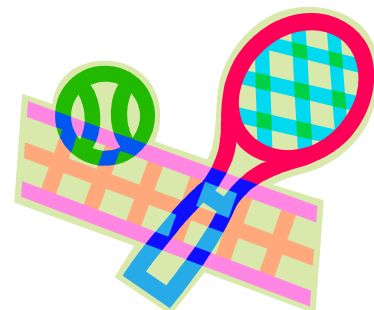
When deciding on the priorities for your time on the above two Saturdays remember that the quality and viability of the club affect the value of what is probably your largest investment - your home.
