Membership Elects New Board Members

At its annual membership meeting on Saturday, November 12, the FSTC membership elected four new members to the board. The new members are:

Karen Angel, Christian Matulich, Bart Smith, Kimberly Cooper

The four new Board members will begin their duties in January, 2006.

Also during the meeting, two proposals were presented, voted upon, and passed. The 4th of July Festivities will now become a Board function and Friday night dinners will not become a Board function.

The Board presented the 2006 budget, proposal for membership increase, and proposal for a membership assessment. Due to by-law requirements, the membership will meet once again to vote on the budget as well as the two proposals.

The membership increase proposal is a 10% increase from \$500 to \$550 for family membership and from \$300 to \$330 for seniors and singles. The proposed assessment is \$200 per year for two years for family membership and \$100 a year for two years for a single/senior membership. New members in 2005 and 2006 would not be assessed these fees. The assessment will cover \$20,000 in pool repairs in 2006 and \$20,000 for tennis court repairs in 2007.

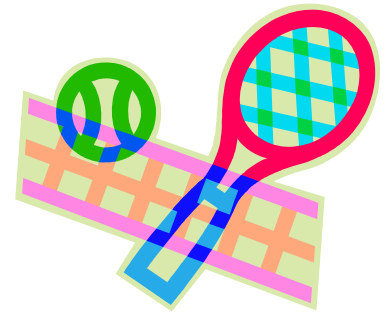
