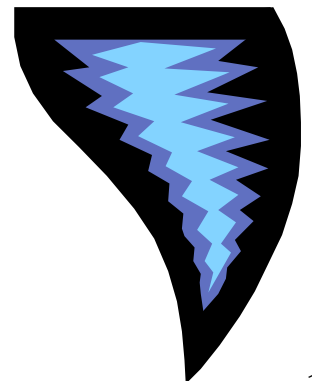
Twisters End Season With a Splash!

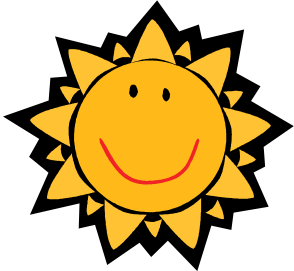
