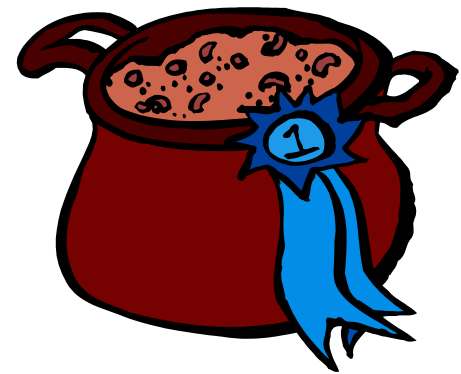

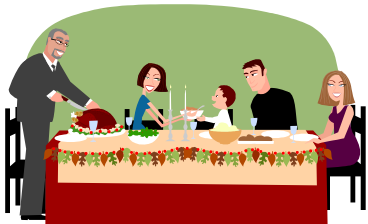
Swim Team News

Due to all of our efforts, Atlanta has become a hotbed for the sport of swimming, not only on the summer league level but on the high school and USS levels as well. We have more than 18,000 young people involved in summer league programs across the city. Realizing this continuing growth, we took a step back and asked, "Why should kids have all the fun?"

We are extremely excited to introduce to you the newest addition to the summer league swimming scene: Atlanta Adult Swim League. The Atlanta Adult Swim League incorporates all the things that are loved about summer swimming and provides adults the opportunity to participate. The meets will include 28 events, divided between male and female, across 2 age groups: 19 - 39 and 40 & over. There will be 4 dual meets in June and a championship meet held at Georgia Tech on July 1st, all occurring Saturday mornings at 9 a.m.

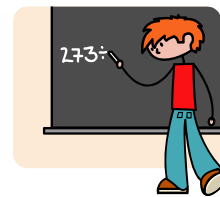
